

Stall drawing form must be turned in no later than Wednesday, July 9, 2008.

Stall drawing will be held Thursday, July 17, 2008 at 7:00 p.m.

Junior Fair Building-Athens Co. Fairgrounds

Each club having livestock that will be exhibited at the 2008 Athens County Fair must submit a stall request form no later than **Wednesday, July 9, 2008**. As stall request forms arrive, they will be assigned a number. During the stall drawing, numbers will be drawn at random and matched to the form containing the same number. The club name and number of pens needed in each species will be written on the respective barn lists posted that evening. **Note: Stalls will be assigned by the barn superintendents once all club forms have been processed and space situations in each barn is assessed. This will allow barn superintendents the ability to provide the maximum amount of stall space per exhibitor with as minimal amount of crowding as possible.** There will be no extra tents ordered in 2008. All barns will be utilized to the extent they were designed. All names of exhibitors on stall request forms will be matched to junior fair records for accuracy. Clubs are not allowed to draw for tack stalls. **Do not draw for open class entries-these will be assessed by species superintendents once registration is complete.** Questions can be directed to the barn superintendents listed in the tabloid. The Fairboard reserves the right to move pen assignments when necessary to accommodate special circumstances or needs. **NOTE:** Clubs must clean all stalls, removing all debris and dividers before any premiums will be paid. If a club has a member who fails to exhibit and the space is dirty, that club is responsible for cleaning it up. Clubs leaving dirty stalls will forfeit all premiums and will be moved to the bottom of the drawing list for the next year. If the entire club fails to exhibit and the stalls are found to be dirty, it will be assumed that surrounding clubs used these areas and they will be held responsible for the removal of all debris, manure and/or other items left behind. Feed sacks, twine and other non-manure type debris should be taken to the closest dumpster outside the barn areas. Manure, straw and hay can be placed in the manure pits outside of the barn areas. All fire codes and electrical codes must be strictly adhered to. Once the Fire Marshall finds an infraction, it must be remedied right away or the exhibitor will lose the use of electrical service until it is. Failure to adhere to the rules may cause the exhibitor the right to exhibit, show and/or sell their animal(s).

By signing this stall request form I, the advisor, agree to all terms, rules, and conditions set forth by the Athens County Agricultural Society, the Ohio Department of Agriculture, Ohio Administrative Code, Ohio's Livestock Reform Act, and all applicable Junior and Senior Fair rules and regulations set forth in the Athens County Fair Premium Tabloid.
