- 4. Separate entry blanks must be used for each person making entry.
- 5. Each exhibitor in a class shall receive the same cash award regardless of placing, and ribbons designating the places shall be given for the number of places designated in a class
- 6. All exhibits must be from projects regularly selected and conducted by students enrolled in agricultural education during 2022-2023. The project selection must be on file in the office of State Supervisor of Agricultural Education.
- 7. No changes will be made to entries after the closing date without the consent of the superintendent in charge.
- 8. Must follow all rules and guidelines set for Junior Fair Exhibition.




